Budget Bites

- 器 Big supermarkets: Rissul, Nacional, Dia, Ferga, Real.
- # Local food: Pão de queijo (cheese bread), acai (superfood), coxinha (chicken), cassava (yucca), paçoca (peanut candy), pamonha (corn dumpling), pastel (deepfried pastry), salgado & kibe & empada (pastry), tapioca, churasco (meat), acarajé (deep-fried prawn snack), rice & beans.
- # Go vegan: Being vegan is ridiculously easy in Brazil. Every bigger supermarket has soy milk (various brands), soy burgers, soy, tofu, vegan cheese and yoghurt etc. Health stores like Mondo Verde have even more choice and cheap soy and veggies you find in weekly markets or at from street vendors. Try the local specialties of pinhão and açaí. Check all vegan-friendly restaurants on Happy Cow.

Mama Said

- Transaction of the safe, but it gets a bit dodgier in Canela. Crime rates aren't that high, but just keep an eye on your belongings and watch out for pickpockets. Cambara is small and safe.
- Boycott zoos like Gramado Zoo, where animals are held in captivity.
- Tap water is generally not drinkable. Use filtered or bottled water.
- Only use licensed cabs or take an Uber.
- Corruption is high in Brazil, especially among cops or government officials. Try to avoid problems with them.

- ❖ Hostels and alternative accommodation are not cheap in Brazil. Camping is possible in summer (this region is rather cold in the winter).

Free-Riding?

- Everything within the centers of Gramado, Canela and Cambara is walkable. These are tiny towns.
- The environment is very suitable for biking. Beware: drivers are not used to cyclists, take extra care.
- City buses bring you everywhere within the centers and to the surrounding villages. You can use a public transport pass or pay cash. Destinations are displayed up front. Download the very helpful Moovit app to plan out inner-city bus routes. Buses are expensive in Brazil!
- Airport Porto Alegre: Aeroporto Internacional Salgado Filho (POA).
- Hitch-hiking is possible, but it is not very safe when coming from Porto Alegre. The city is surrounded by slums which are certainly not recommended to enter or get near to as a foreigner. Instead, use apps like Blablacar to get a cheap(er) ride.

Tip: Download the Triposo Brazil app for offline maps, landmark descriptions & more, or load Google Maps when you have Wi-Fi and leave it open, you will still be able to use it offline.
