## Free-Riding?

- Frankfurt is easily walkable.
- Biking is a good option. Check some enjoyable routes <u>here</u>!
- Taxis are metered, but very expensive.
- Trams serve the city. Find a tramway map <u>here</u>!

■ The metro is called U-Bahn. The suburban rail service Rapid Transit goes to the suburbs. For a S-bahn and U-bahn map, <u>click here</u>.

- The train is a good option within and outside Frankfurt. Plan your trip on <u>this website</u>.
- Bus travel is pretty irrelevant in Germany, but really cheap to get from city to city. Check <u>Eurolines</u>, or compare prices at <u>Busradar</u>.

■ Hitch-hiking is common and doable, but there's always a risk. In order to pre-arrange a ride & share gas costs, try carpool websites like <u>Blablacar</u>, <u>Carpoolworld</u> or Facebook-groups, there are many.

<u>Frankfurt Airport</u> can be reached by S-bahn (S8 & S9) or bus (line 61). Check your terminal!

Tip 1: Buy a day ticket, which is way cheaper than several 1-ways. You can use it for all public transport.

Tip 2: Download the Triposo Germany app for offline maps, landmark descriptions & more, or load Google Maps when you have Wi-Fi and leave it open, you will still be able to use it offline.
