History Recap Over 1 Drink

1502: Columbus arrives in New World (Panama+Honduras). 1509: Beginning slave trade. 1513: Pacific Ocean claimed by Spain (Balboa) → Spanish settlers. 1519: Ciudad de Panamá founded. 1617: Pirates (Morgan). 1810: Spanish king overthrown by Napoleon → 1821: Independent of Spain, joins Gran Colombia (Colombia/Venezuela/Peru/Ecuador/Bolivia), 1830: Part of Colombia. 1850s: Panama Railway. 1880s: France failed to build Panamá Canal linking Atlantic & Pacific / Independence movement. 1903: Panama independent from Colombia. US (Roosevelt) buys rights (\$40mln) to build Panamá Canal → 1913-15 done (65km). 1936: Begin Pan-American Highway project. 1940s: US government tests weapons in Panamá. 1955: President Remon assassinated. 60s: Guerilla tensions from Cuba, US backs ups Panamá. 1964: Anti-American riots → killings (mostly Panamanians). 1985: Noriega took power (bribery/murder/drugs trafficking). 1999: 1st female president Moscoso. 2006: Seat in US Security Council. 2014: Venezuela breaks ties with Panamá.

- © Put on your hiking shoes and explore! From Bocas you have the easiest entrance to Amistad National Park.
- © Surf's up: Black Rock, Caranero, Wizard Beach etc.
- © Beach breaks: Playa Bluff (Colon), Estrella (Colon), Starfish Beach (Colon), Boca del Drago (Bastimentos), Red Frog Beach (Bastimentos / \$3 entrance).
- Have lunch at Bibi's (Isla Caranero) and use their kayaks, stand-up paddle boards and snorkeling gear.
- © Do a free tour at <u>Smithsonian Tropical Research</u> Institute.
- © Walk or bicycle around the islands.

Worth The Extra \$€¥

- Explore the islands: Isla Colon, Isla Bastimentos (National Marine Park), Isla Zapatillas, Isla Caranero & Isla San Cristobal.
- Watersports: <u>Scubadiving</u>, <u>Sailing</u>, <u>Snorkelling</u>, <u>Sportfishing</u>, Stand-up paddle boarding.
- Refresh with some voga.
- Tours: <u>Botanical Garden</u>, <u>Chocolate Tour</u>, <u>Caving</u>, <u>Canopy</u>, <u>Sea turtle hatching</u>, <u>Dolphin Preserve</u>.
- Grab a horse.

Tourist Trap Alert

- Avoid Isla Colon if you don't like tourist hangouts, visit Isla San Cristobal or Isla Bastimentos instead.
- Before looking into tours, check which daytrips you can arrange: Fishermen can take you to certain locations on their boats.

Budget Bites

- ₩ Be ready to spend, Bocas is not cheap. Self-catering by shopping in the mostly Chinese-owned supermarkets.
- **Main** square: Snackbar with cheap deals.
- **X** Streetfood is not so varied in Panama: Hot dogs (*perro caliente*), skewers, hamburgers, and *raspado* ice creams.

Mama Said

- The surf can be dangerous with strong riptides.
- Opposed to everywhere else in Panamá, tap water is not safe to drink in Bocas del Toro.
- You can get fined for walking around shirtless.
- Drugs are readily available but NOT legal, penalties are high.
- Bring enough cash. There's only 1 bank in Bocas on Isla Colon.

Free-Riding?

- The islands are small and most is walkable. To explore Isla Colon a bike or public transport is recommendable.
- To get there: Take a bus to Almirante from where you can take a boat. Buses on Isla Colon run from Bocas Plaza to Bocas del Drago.
- Boats connect the islands and go according to schedules. You can also hire boaters operating motorized boats and canoes.
- Taxi's are pricy for South American standards... and take your precautions. Foreigner = money.
