- Monchique: There are many indicated trails which are all free. Recommended: The trail to Mount Foia.
- © Carvoeiro: The geological formations of Algar Seco & the modern boardwalk.

- **& Local food:** Mariscos (sea food), Arroz de Pato (duck risotto), Bacalhau (fish), Porco Preto (pork), Cozido a Portuguesa (stew), Caldo Verde (soup), Feijoada (meat-bean stew), Amêijoas à Bulhão Pato (clams), Alheira de Mirandela (sausage), Queijo da Serra (cheese), Bolo do Caco (bread), Polvo à Lagareiro (octopus), Arroz Doce (desert).
- **Go vegan:** Being vegan is ridiculously easy in Europe and also in Portugal. Every bigger supermarket has an endless supply of vegan products and there are many vegan/vegetarian restaurants. Check them here: Happy Cow Algarve.

Mama Said

- The Algarve is, as most parts of Europe, a pretty safe region... but use your common sense like everywhere. Don't walk anywhere alone after sunset, don't take valuables along and always follow your instinct.
- Boycott zoos or aquariums like Lagos Zoo, Krazy World and Zoomarine where animals are held in captivity.
- Tap water is drinkable.
- Only use licensed cabs or take an Uber.
- Avoid Albufeira. Can't stress if often enough.

Free-Riding?

- The towns in the Algarve region are usually rather small, so within the city center most things are on walking distance.
- The Algarve has relatively good roads and biking can be great fun. In summer it's too hot during the day.
- City buses and trains operate between different towns in the Algarve and the rest of Portugal, but don't go very often. For a good overview check the official and unofficial website.
- Airport: Aeroporto de Faro (FAO).
- Hitch-hiking is relatively safe, although not very common. You can also use apps like <u>Blablacar</u> to get a cheap(er) ride.
